Incident reporting - Need a way of reporting incidents on site via the website - Ian

Financials: circa £3k in current account.

Circa £25K in old account. Need to get Adrian / Jon to bank to transfer old account to new account.

Grants: Georgina Williams Trust, Canoe foundation grants, BC funding. – need to look at each of these, and any others, and determine criteria, cut off dates etc.

Boat clear out: Hold off until warmer, Do at early May Weekend.

Keep White Water racers. Iain has the photos of the surplus boats however more likely to do a tip run.. Also contact council / shops for recycling opportunities.

40ft Container: Potential to convert a portion into changing rooms. Install racking for additional boats at one end. Neil to draw up some sketches of canopy idea.

Road to lower parking – does this need looking at to get an estimate for filling? Look to re-clad toilets / changing rooms. – At May weekend – need a Project manager – Wayne Look to roof the Long container – Project manager – Mark ?
